Questions

- 1. How do we apply Paul's emphasis on the communion of saints in the world church to the reality of our current church and educational situation, which in many cases is characterized by brokenness, church tribalism, theological-cultural conservatism, spiritual individualism, and fear that foreign error doctrine may creep in?
- 2. Western Christians often emphasize their rational thinking and knowing of the truth. What can we learn from the emphasis in Ephesians 3:17-21 on knowing Christ's love? And what can we learn from Paul's emphasis on thanksgiving and intercession regarding the unity of the church, both locally and globally?
- 3. What can we do to give "with all the saints" more shape in church, school and society?
